WELLAND PUBLIC LIBRARY CELEBRATES COLLABORATION WITH DSNB



The Welland Public Library Board is collaborating with the District School Board of Niagara on an initiative that will see the Welland Public Library incorporated into the new, soon-to-be-built Mathews Public School.

This exciting and innovative initiative is the first of its kind in Niagara, and will see the public library and the school library share the same space. During the day, the library will operate as a school library, serving the students at the school. In the evening and on weekends, the library will operate as a branch of the Welland Public Library, offering a full complement of services and resources.

The new school will be built on the current site of Mathews Public School on Southworth Street and is expected to open in September 2013. Construction is planned to begin this summer.

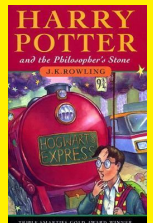


Imagine a world of fantasy and fun at the Welland Public Library this summer by joining the TD Summer Reading Club.

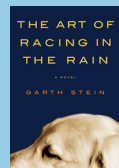

FRENCH MOVIE TIME

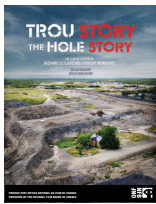
