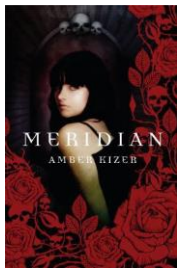
“Eternal” by Cynthia Leitich Smith

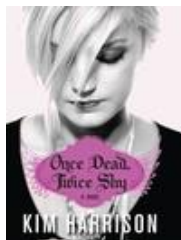
“Fallen” by Lauren Kate
