



Public Displays and Bulletin Boards Policy

Date of Last Revision: April 18, 2016

The Welland Public Library has free display space available system-wide for postings and exhibits of community interest. Possible display areas include glass display cases, bulletin boards, shelves, ledges, wall space, and other areas at the discretion of Library Management (CEO or designate).

Acceptable displays and postings include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Displays of cultural or historical importance
- Displays relevant to the Welland/Niagara region
- Displays showcasing the work of local artists and artisans
- Displays promoting local community groups/non-profits

Unacceptable displays and postings include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Displays with political, religious or partisan content
- Displays with a commercial or fundraising purpose
- Displays with advertisements or solicitations for business

The Library is not responsible for loss or damage to items or materials on display. Displays and postings must meet space requirements, schedule availability, and the approval of relevant affiliate organizations (e.g. Diamond Trail School), and must not unduly impact staff time.

Library Management (CEO or designate) reserves the right to refuse any proposed display/posting.
