

# Print with Google Cloud Print


With Google Cloud Print, you can print from various applications in the same way you print to local printers.

To start printing, [search and install applications](#) that allow you to use Google Cloud Print.

Print files from your computer

1. Visit the [Google Cloud Print management page](#).
2. Click **Print**.
3. Choose **Upload file to print > Select a file from my computer**.
4. Select a file and **Open**.
5. Choose your printer and click **Print**.

Print with Google Chrome

1. In the top right of your browser, click **menu** .
2. Select **Print**.
3. In the "Destination" section, click **Change**.
4. Choose your printer and click **Print**.

**Note:** If your printer options are disabled when you try to use the Google Cloud Printer, they may not be compatible with the cloud printer you selected.
